Dear Family

I was pleased to be able to provide you with a further update on our plans to create and build 'Space Village' on the school field to replace the 22 classrooms that we are currently unable to use. I am delighted to tell you that after a late phone call on Friday evening to the Department for Education, we received the approval, funding and sign-off to engage with one of our contractors. The organisation that will be working with us is called Losberger De Boer.

Space Village is about making the impossible, possible, and as such, our contractors will be working long days, seven days a week. They have already started preliminary work on site ready to begin construction next week. This morning, we have had the site marked out and this afternoon a ground survey will be taking place. Later this week, the trackways will begin along with work to connect to services. Once construction starts, we expect that it will take four weeks to complete Space Village.

(Week 4-6: 25th September - 11th October) Space Village Phase 1: Block 1 - 11 classrooms


- Site preparation: Monday/Tuesday 25th 26th September

(Week 5-7: 11th October) Space Village Phase 2: Block 2 - 11 classrooms


- Start construction second 20m x 60m building: Wednesday 4th October
- Start internal fit-out: Wednesday 11th October
- Finish: Wednesday 18th October
- Contingency and finishing day: Thursday 19th October
- Handover Phase 2: Friday 20th October
