## Cohort 9 Nuclear Wild Forest Enrichment Experience - Tuesday 5th March 2024

We are excited to share with families that we have arranged a day for C9 to visit Nuclear Wild Forest in Brentwood on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March.

Nuclear Wild Forest is a unique and fun obstacle course teaching teamwork, motivation, mindset, focus, resilience, self-confidence, determination and friendship. Being outdoors and around nature, completing the course alongside their peers and teachers will be a memorable experience.

Learners will depart by bus from Honywood at 9am arriving at Nuclear Wild Forest for 10am. This course is very muddy and adds another level of challenge for the learners. They should wear old sports clothing which is comfortable and be prepared to get muddy. They will start the course at 10:30am alongside their teachers. Instructors are on the course at various points to give guidance and safety advice. A full briefing takes place before they commence the course.

They will have a picnic style lunch and so will need to bring a packed lunch with them for the day. In addition, they will require a complete change of clothing. Hot outdoor washdowns and changing rooms are available for the learners after they finish the course. We will depart for school at 2pm to return in time for the end of the school day.

We have been able to secure a grant from the Jack Petchey Foundation to cover the majority of the transport costs which considerably reduces the cost of this trip to £24.00. Could you please make payment on ParentPay by Friday 9th February so that we can confirm final attendee numbers with Nuclear Wild.

In addition, Nuclear Wild Forest requires families to sign a disclaimer. I have attached a copy of the document for you to read. When making payment, could you please confirm your acceptance of the disclaimer by checking the box provided.

• I am aged 16 or over.
• I understand that all activities undertaken at Nuclear Races (NR) are physically and mentally challenging and there are risks involved. This includes but is not limited to water based, surface, trip, slip and eye hazards.
• I am fit and well and not on any medication of any sort that would impede me taking part in any activity and if I am that I have sought medical advice from my doctor before taking part and made NR aware & will make the medic aware on the day of the event.
• I consent to emergency medical care and transportation in the event of injury to me in order to obtain treatment medical professional deem appropriate.
• I will comply with all instructions given to me by the organisers, employees and volunteers of NR and will use equipment correctly and as directed (if necessary) so as not to hurt or injure anyone.
• I understand that NR reserves the right to cancel or modify any Events/activity if NR feels such conditions would otherwise create an unsafe environment.
• I give permission to the NR to use my photo and/or any other record of my participation at NR for any legitimate purpose. I understand that all likenesses of me captured during the event/activity by the organisation or staff shall become the sole property of the NR.
• I have declared any medical conditions, which may risk my own safety and that of others, to one of the members of staff.
• Although Wild Forest (WF) facilities has strict safety standards and is risk assessed the risk of serious injury or death associated with WF cannot be totally eliminated. Therefore I understand that participation in activities and the use of facilities at WF is entirely at my own risk. Furthermore, I understand it's my responsibility to only attempt an obstacle or training if it's safe to do so and is within my capabilities.
• I understand that the land owner tests some but not all of the water used in the obstacles for microbiology. This is done on a risk of ingestion basis.
• I agree that as to any equipment, which I provide or borrow from WF during use of the facilities, that WF shall not be liable for any loss or damage due to my/participants misuse or my negligence.
• I agree that WF are not responsible for any personal items or property that are lost or stolen at WF.
• I agree that I will not sue, or otherwise make any claim against WF, or its employees, agents, and contractors due to my negligence or misuse of an obstacle.
• As the guardian of a child under the age of 16yrs old I hereby agree to WF Representative supervising my child during their activity at WF and understand that all reasonable care will be taken to ensure the child's safety.
