Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: C11 Spring Enrichment Week 18th March 2024

We are delighted to once again bring our Spring Enrichment programme to learners and families, whereby on a given week, each cohort will be taking part in activities either on site or off. Our focus for C11 for their Enrichment week is preparing them for the challenges they will face over the next few months with their GCSE exams, culminating in a day out to celebrate their time together as learning groups and as a cohort, whilst developing life skills and confidence. We have designed the following programme for your child designed to support their forthcoming exams, and to build confidence:

Monday	Maths Intervention Day.
18 th March	The learners will work with their Maths teacher to look at revision material and exam technique and
	sit a mock paper.
Tuesday	Science Intervention Day.
19 th March	The learners will work with their Science teachers to look at revision materials and exam technique and will sit a mock paper on the day.
Wednesday	English Language Intervention Day.
20 th March	The learners will work with their English teachers to look at revision materials and exam technique and will sit a mock paper on the day.
Thursday	London Scavenger Hunt.
21 st March	The whole cohort will visit London for the day. Their task will be to work out the clues as a group and visit as many sites using the London Underground and on foot. The clues and sights will lead to the final destination and meet point before returning home.
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	Planning will take place in advance in LS5 time with their Learning Group Leader and we hope that this will give them some 'downtime' as a cohort from exams, whilst developing skills and independence. They will collaborate to work out their route and work out the clues, whilst staff are with them, the learners will make decisions about the route they will take.
	Learners will take a coach to Stratford and will be given a Travel Card to use for the day. <u>Please</u> <u>arrange for your child to be at school by 7:30am so we may leave promptly at 7:45am.</u>
	The learners will work in their Learning Groups and will be accompanied by their Learning Group leader and additional staff. They will all meet up for lunch at Covent Garden to check in, and then be back at Stratford for the coach home by 4pm; we will update families on the day as to our expected return time to school.
Friday	English Literature Intervention Day.
22 nd March	The learners will work with their English teachers to look at revision materials and exam technique
	and will sit a mock paper on the day.

The cost for the day to London, which covers the coach and the Travelcard **is £32.00**. Payments can be made on ParentPay (preferred method and includes a 1.275% charge). If any family is experiencing financial difficulty, please contact the school at <u>trips@honywoodschool.com</u>.

Payment must be made by 7th March as we need to purchase the Travelcards at least ten days in advance of the trip. IF THIS DEADLINE IS MISSED, WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ADD TO THE TICKETS.
