Honywood Ski trip February 2025

We are excited to announce that we will be organising a Honywood Ski Trip 2025 to Dachstein West, Austria, in the February half term holiday departing on Friday 17th February, returning on Saturday 25th February 2025.

There is no requirement for your child to be able to ski. All learners will be in Ski School irrespective of their ability, with learners being grouped according to their previous ski experience and ski ability.

We have worked hard to negotiate the best possible price without compromising on the premium experience that we would like our learners to benefit from. The full price of the trip, including professional ski instruction, lift passes, ski and boot hire, full board accommodation, evening activities, food and all travel costs is £1705, with a small surcharge for snowboarders.

The initial deposit is non-refundable should your child withdraw from the visit. We are bound by the travel companies' terms and conditions and therefore, should your child withdraw at any time, any refunds will be in accordance with their terms and conditions, on a sliding scale along with any bank charges incurred.)

Once all places have been secured, this item will no longer be payable on ParentPay.
